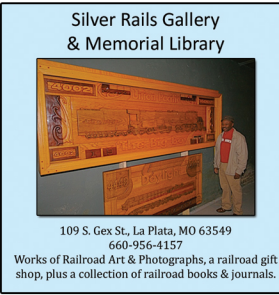


FREE MAP OF SILVER RAILS COUNTRY.COM

H8-Gilbreath-McLorn Victorian House 225 N. Owensby St., Built in 1896, Added to National Register of Historic Places in 1978. Tours by Appointment. Contact Nancy Belfield at 660-216-9755 or 660-332-4224.



H8-Doneghy Victorian House 301 N. St., Built in 1895, Added to National Owens. Register of Historic Places in 1989



H8-Lester Dent House 225 N. Church St., Lester Dent was author of the "Doc Savage" pulp novels of the 1930's and 1940's. The house was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1990. Interior not open to the public. Please do not disturb residents.

M15-Thomas Hill Conservation Area Main entrance is 5.25 miles west of Macon on Highway 36, then 10 miles south on Route C to College Mound, and 2.4 miles west on Route T, Campground, boat ramps, boat docks, picnic areas, a fishing jetty, and 4,950 acres of fishable water. The area also has a waterfowl refuge north of Route T and upland hunting on several thousand acres. A heated water discharge canal offers unique winter fishing opportunities. Individual campsites, Fishing: Bass, Catfish, Crappie, Other, Hunting: Deer, Dove, Quail, Rabbit, Squirrel, Turkey, Waterfowl, Bird Watching.
